If you're selling a product that needs a mockup, logo, or any other marketing tactics you'll want to visit a design site, but what's out there and what do you need to make your dream a reality?

If you want to do some comparison shopping, save some design time, or just learn a little bit more about what you can use in the future, we've compiled this list of BLANK design site alternatives for your perusing pleasure.

Smartmockups: For Any Browser Mockups

Smartmockups is an all in one quick mockup site with royalty free assets for any use. You don't need any other apps or experience to use it and it has multiple 3rd party integrations for a seamless workflow.

The site allows you to make mockups for:

- Any phone or laptop screen
- Promotional print items
- Consumer packaging
- Apparel
- Social media sites
- Merch

Smartmockups has an interesting trial period unlike others where you can continue to use the free version after your trial has ended. These free mockups do have a watermark on them that can be removed with a plan upgrade. The site gives you 200 free mockups with access to its basic features.

The premium version of a subscription costs \$14/month or \$108/year and gives you the ability to:

- Change product colors
- Change backgrounds
- Crop mockups
- Take screenshots of URLs

The [pro](#) subscription costs \$24/month or \$228/year and it gives you everything above and:

- Mockups with your own photos
- Video mockups

- Gif mockups
- Custom watermarks
- Auto saving as you work

The team subscription costs \$84/month or \$828/year, and it gives you access to everything for up to ten users. It also gives you team specific abilities like:

- Easy team management
- A hub for team favorites
- Priority customer service
- Invoice payments

Adobe XD: For Innovative UI Design

Adobe XD is an app design tool that focuses on UI [innovation](#). If you want designs that pop and a high degree of control, Adobe XD might be what you're looking for.

Some key draws Adobe has over other UI design sites are:

- Animation
- Interactive prototyping
- Cross-platform testing
- 3D product views
- Reusable assets
- Quick and painless iteration
- Wireframing
- Integration with other apps

The app has [three](#) pricing plans:

- XD(Free) Starter
- XD (Single) App
- All (Adobe) Apps

The starter version of Adobe XD has no trial period but is limited in its abilities. XD Starter gives you:

- Access to all tools
- 1 shared doc
- 1 extra editor
- 10 days of document history
- 2GB of cloud storage
- Limited fonts

The single app costs \$9.99/month or \$119.88/year and allows:

- Unlimited shared docs
- Unlimited editors
- 30 days of doc history
- 100GB of cloud storage
- All fonts

If you buy all apps for an annual plan of \$52.99/month, a monthly plan of \$79.49/month or an annual plan of \$599.88/year you can access all Adobe products as well as extend your document history to 60 days.

You can also buy the single app for your team for \$22.99/month or \$275.88/yr or all apps for \$79.99/month or \$959.88/yr.

Graphic Burger: For a Creative Community

Graphic Burger is an absolutely free [community](#) design site that offers:

- Mockups
- UI Samples
- Icons
- Fonts
- Background themes
- Social media layouts

You're allowed to use any of the designs for personal and commercial projects and you can even contribute your own graphics to contribute to the design community.

Some of the interesting mockups Graphic Burger has on their [site](#) are for:

- Phones
- Vans
- Leggings
- Aprons
- Helmets
- Stamps

They also have some highly creative:

- 3D text effects
- Diverse flat icons
- Colorful textured backgrounds

The site is arranged a bit like a blog with each design having its own excerpt and download file to use in Photoshop.

Clipart.me (Formerly Designmoo): For Quirky Clipart

Clipart.me is another design site that calls itself a [network](#) of designers and offers royalty free downloadable content like:

- Mockups
- Clipart
- Backgrounds

While some of their content is free there are [pricing plans](#) as well as a la carte prices for more quality content through iStock for as low as \$2.90/image/month up to \$9.90/image/month depending on the package you select.

The difference between what you get for the two packages (Basic and Premium) all comes down to access of library images. Premium grants you full access while Basic only grants access to the website's essential photos.

Don't worry though, if you don't want to spend any money you still can get unique clipart like:

- Motorcycle riding pigs
- Tire tracks
- Celtic knots
- Helpful owls
- Kebab-filled grills
- Puzzle pieces
- Cozy farms

Regardless of what plan you pick you can use the assets for personal and commercial uses.

Mockingbird: For Fast Wireframing

Mockingbird is strictly wireframe site that you can try for free for seven days. After the seven days are up, your project will become a read only file until you upgrade your account. This site is for people who want to get an idea of how their website for a product or brand will look and feel when time is of the essence.

Some of its features [include](#):

- Drag and drop set ups
- Interactive linking

- Real-time editing with collaborators
- Unlimited collaborators

Mockingbird charges by [number](#) of projects you create monthly or yearly after the free trial is up so you can determine what plan you need. See our table below.

Pixelbuddha: For Exclusive Membership Perks

Pixelbuddha is a download-centered design site with free and payment tiers for select quality content. You can sign up for \$10/month or \$59/year. You can also purchase premium content separately a la carte.

The site's main draw is its limited-time, creative, exclusive bonuses for [Plus](#) members delivered straight to their emails. So, if you like getting original promotional items, this site is for you!

The site includes some of the following downloads:

- Animations
- Illustrations
- Mockups
- UI kits
- Brushes

Pixel Buddha also has some very interesting and specific mockups such as:

- Car advertisements

- Cufflinks

LS Graphics: For Eye Catching Scenes

LS Graphics is a media site that specializes in downloads for:

- An annual full access library subscription for \$99/year

Some designs LS Graphics does [exceptionally well](#) are the:

The scenes in are particularly interesting because they are bright and highly customizable with many items to choose from to create any scene you can imagine.

[Freepik: For Restaurant Food Mockups](#)

Freepik is a media site that allows you up to 5 free [downloads](#) each day with attribution. If you don't want to attribute content or if you want access to more quality content you can purchase a subscription for \$14.99/month or \$83.99 for the first year.

With a premium account you also get:

- A maximum of 100 downloads/day
- No ads
- Priority customer service

One draw to Freepik is it has a good amount of quality [food](#) layouts for advertising.

Freepik also has great mockup designs for:

- Patches
- Athleisure
- Clothing labels
- Purses
- USB sticks

Medialoot: For Well-Rounded Media Downloads

Medialoot is a media site that offers [downloads](#) for:

- Mockups
- Graphics
- Templates
- Themes
- Icons
- Fonts

Medialoot has some free content with the option to purchase a plan for \$14/month, \$79/year, or \$99/year (non-reoccurring), or if you only want to buy one thing you can buy some things piece meal.

All plans give you:

- Unlimited downloads
- Hassel-free membership cancelation
- The ability to keep all downloads forever
- An extended license

The site also offers some novelty mockups like:

- Raffle tickets
- Door hangers
- Messenger bags

Mockplus: For a Plugin Palooza

Mockplus recently got an update and self-identifies as an “[all in one product design platform](#).” One of the major selling points of this design site is its high degree of collaboration abilities between teams and customization.

They specialize in:

- UI development
- Design
- Interactive prototypes

The site works with various plugins and devices that can be used with its two products Mockplus cloud for designing and Mockplus Classic for prototyping. Refer to our table below.

There is a 15 day free trial for both Mockplus products after which you will have to purchase a plan.

Mockplus Cloud packages cost \$7.95/month for Pro or \$17.95/month for Ultimate or \$71.40/year or \$155.40/year respectively and are differentiated by number of:

- Users
- Projects
- High quality prototypes
- Pages in a prototype
- Task in a project

So you can choose based on what volume of work your business does.

Mockplus classic can run you anywhere from \$199/year to \$29999/year depending on if you want:

- Annual billing
- A one lifetime charge
- More users
- More storage
- Management settings
- More overall control

Lastly, you can even contact Mockplus for a [custom](#) plan and they can tailor it to you!

[Proto.io](#): For Engaging Micro-Animations

Proto.io is a UI prototyping design site that focuses on design [functionality](#) for an easy and captivating user experience.

The draws to this media site are its:

- Drag and drop functionalities
- Animated icons
- Audio effects
- Sequential and parallel actions
- Design tools

One intriguing aspect of Proto.io is what they call micro-animations. They are small animations like a tumbling leaf or skipped stone that adds a little ambiance to a prototype without being distracting or having to put a lot of work into them

Proto.io also has a winning free trial period that many can appreciate. It is full-featured for 15 days you can then upgrade your plan to a paid version or get a free [limited](#) ability version.

The paid version of Proto.io starts at \$29/month to \$199/month or \$288/year \$1920/year based on number of:

- Users
- Active projects

All packages allow for unlimited reviewers, so you never have to worry about keeping track of them.

Creative Market: For Supporting Freelance Designers

Creative Market is a site constructed like a [marketplace](#) for freelance designers to sell their content directly to you. If supporting small businesses is your cup of tea, this site is your go-to.

The services Creative Market offers are:

Creative Market pricing is per project and varies depending on what license type you want. There also is no free version of the site, however there are ways to get extra goods or credits from the site.

Ceacle is a prototyping and mockup download site that helps you make great [presentations](#). The site is laid out in a simplistic and sleek fashion that easy on the eye and highlights their strengths.

Hotgloo is a wireframing and prototyping tool that [boasts](#) its accessibility for those who have never used a design site before. It even offers a bunch of helpful documentation to make setting up your UI/UX mockup a breeze.

The site is straightforward and professional looking. It also has:

- Easy team collaboration
- Mobile optimization
- One of the most comprehensive element libraries
- Interactive wireframing

Another great thing about Hotgloo is it can be accessed from any device and requires no downloads!

Hotgloo has a full featured free 7 day trial that requires no credit card. It also has pricing plans that go up in price depending on the number of:

- Users
- Projects

All pricing tiers have unlimited reviewers.

For Graphic is a design studio site that specializes in [high-quality](#) mockups that you can purchase and download per package.

This site is another one that supports independent artists, so you know your money is benefiting artists who really need it!

[Shotsnap](#): For in Browser Device Mockups

Shotsnap is exclusively a device mockup site that you can use completely online! This is your site if you're looking to design a mockup with no downloads for your:

- App
- Website
- Product
- Design

The tool is completely free; however you can upgrade to a paid plan for \$36 for the whole year.

The Basic Shotsnap experience includes:

- Templates
- Hand-picked photos
- One item per canvas limit
- PNG or JPG exports

The Pro Shotsnap experience includes unlimited:

- Items per canvas
- Templates
- Photos
- Devices

Facebook Design: For Everything Facebook

- Oil pastel

So if your product is in need of an original splash of originality this is the site for you!
